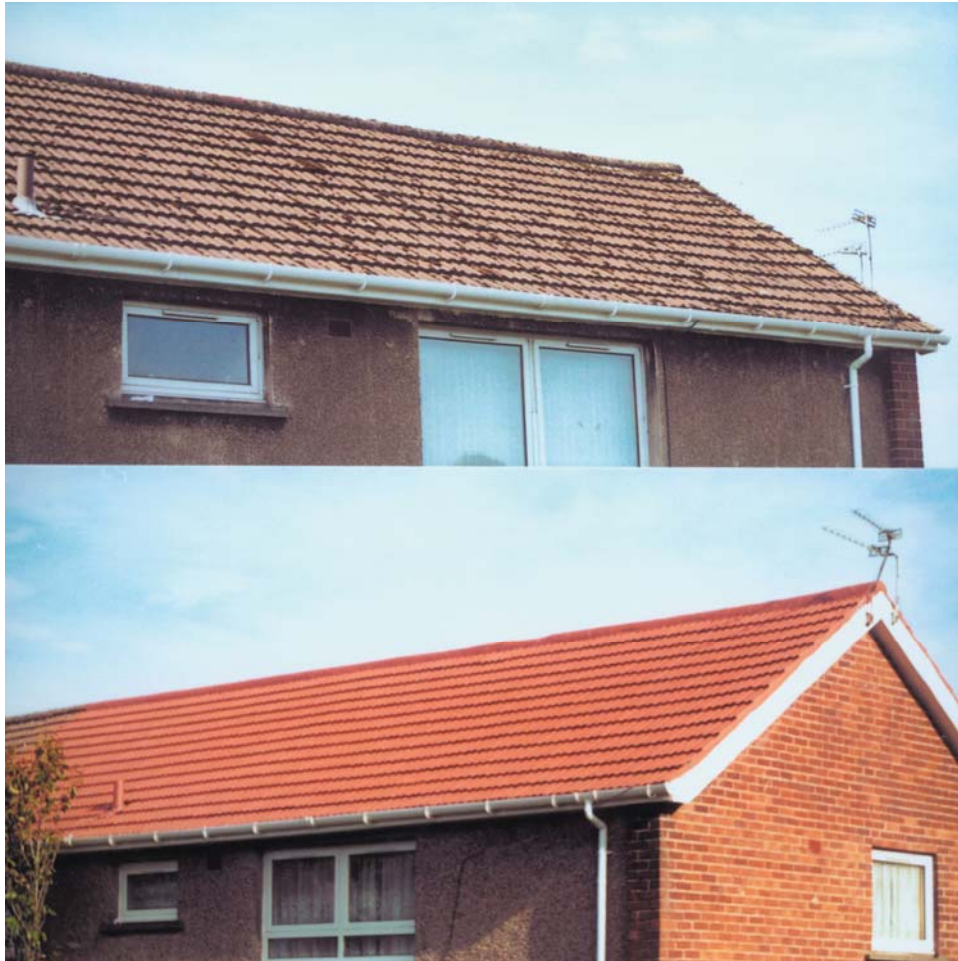


## WESLO HOUSING MANAGEMENT TURNS TO NU-LIFE

Weslo Housing Management, set up in 1994 specifically to acquire and manage 1822 Scottish Homes houses in West Lothian and a further 500 in Bo'Ness specified Nu-Life which was installed by Roofseal Scotland Limited of Edinburgh, as part of an exterior structural refurbishment project to 16 blocks scheduled for completion during Summer 2003.

Nu-Life, now available in all the most popular pitched roof colours – red, terracotta, brown, grey and green – will also counter the build up of moss, fungi, lichens and water retention, which together add weight and stress to the roof structure and can cause contamination to gutters and drainage channels.

The product will also protect against frost damage, lower internal condensation levels and help prevent against extreme cases of water build up caused by roof debris which can lead to rainwater penetrating overlaps.

Easy to apply, Nu-Life, which has been developed by solution experts Acrypol, is available through most leading building and roofing merchants. The product is water based so that all brushes and tools used during application can be easily cleaned and takes around six hours to dry, subject to weather conditions, once applied to the roofscape.
